



## Art centre with focus on creativity

Skissernas Museum has the potential to become a world-class art institution and creative meeting place. With its focus on the creative process, the museum is unique. The high-quality collections, with works by artists including Henri Matisse, Fernand Léger, Sonia Delaunay, Henry Moore and Diego Rivera, form a basis from which to make Skissernas Museum into one of northern Europe's major art attractions. This requires change. Below we describe the development opportunities that we can realise with your support and involvement.

The work to transform the museum is about taking responsibility for the museum as a whole and can be described in three parts: exterior transformation (extension), interior transformation (revitalisation), and behind-the-scenes transformation (infrastructure and collections).

### EXTERIOR TRANSFORMATION

The exterior transformation is an extension of the museum to create a new foyer with a restaurant – an important element in the promotion of the museum as an innovative meeting place. This project is largely already funded thanks to a large anonymous donation.

### BEHIND-THE-SCENES TRANSFORMATION

The behind-the-scenes transformation involves the digitalisation of the collections in order to improve accessibility for researchers and the public. The project is fully funded through large grants from Riksbankens Jubileumsfond (SEK 7.5 million) and the Crafoord Foundation (SEK 1.5 million). What remains now is the interior transformation, which is the most important part of the work.

### INTERIOR TRANSFORMATION

A thorough revitalisation and modernisation will aim to freshen up the museum with respect for tradition and the museum's special atmosphere. This includes a new, environmentally friendly lighting strategy to highlight the collections in a better manner than at present, a review of the hanging of the collections, the installation of interactive storage cabinets that offer visitors the opportunity to interact with more works in new ways, improved interpretive materials, with audioguides and digital displays in the galleries, colour profiling of the museum interior, increased external visibility in the form of signs, a new graphic profile and website, and activation of the sculpture park outside the museum.

### INTERNATIONAL MEETING PLACE

A roof over the museum's exposed courtyard would enable the creation of a flexible meeting and project room in the heart of the museum. This multi-purpose room could provide a space for large or small meetings of groups from management teams to government ministers. Skissernas Museum will form an exclusive and inspiring venue for conferences, seminars, discussions or dinners in a secluded and unique environment. This project is also largely funded thanks to a private donation.

### JUBILEE EXHIBITION AND PUBLICATION

The museum's 75th anniversary will coincide with the start of the celebrations for Lund University's 350th anniversary. The museum is planning a large thematic exhibition with international loans relating principally to the museum's collections of 20th century French masters. As part of its transformation work, the museum will put together the first ever catalogue of the museum collections. The intention is for this to serve as both an academic resource and an elegant publication to be used to spread information about the museum and the University.

### FUNDING NEEDS

In order to meet the need for development of Skissernas Museum and realise our ideas, additional funding is needed. The interior transformation of the museum requires SEK 5 million, the completion of an international meeting place SEK 3 million, the jubilee exhibition SEK 1 million and SEK 500 000 for a catalogue of the collections.

All donations are welcome, whether large or small. Together we can work for a better world.
